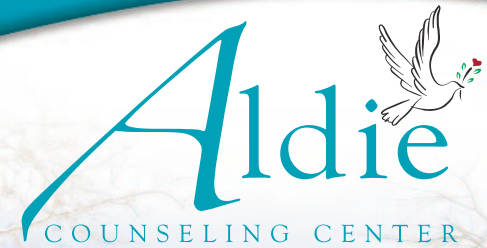

## Transition House

## Our Services

Aldie's transition house is located in Doylestown, about a block north of the Bucks County Courthouse. The program provides a safe, supportive environment for men in the early stages of recovery from chemical dependency.



Candidates are interviewed by the Transition House Coordinator at Aldie Counseling Center. Interviews can take place at the Bucks County Correctional Facility, area hospitals, and rehabilitation facilities. The candidate's motivation for recovery and need for housing are primary considerations.

Sobriety goals, vocational goals, family goals and treatment goals are set at the beginning of a house member's stay. The residents meet with the house manager each month to review progress toward goals and to focus on concrete steps needed to achieve the goals.



## Criteria for Admission Includes

- Ability to obtain employment and/or vocational training
- Completion of detox and/or abstinence for a minimum of 14 days
- Commitment to six months of housing program participation
- Abidance by house guidelines, including appropriate behavior and goal-setting
- Agreement to engage in recommended level of treatment
- Compliance with funding requests/requirements
- Participation in house groups and activities
- Prior to admission two weeks rent payment in advance
- Ability to walk up two flights of stairs and handle basic chores

New residents need to bring a desire to get and stay sober, their clothing, and personal toiletries. Meals are provided with residents participating in meal planning and cooking in a family atmosphere.

To foster accountability and responsibility, residents participate in upkeep of the house.

Aldie's goal is to help residents gain new life skills to maintain their sobriety and become productive and successful.

Drug and alcohol use is not tolerated and we reserve the right to randomly screen all residents. At Aldie House you can find the support of others in different stages of recovery. Residents are supervised by experienced staff that has helped a variety of people build richer, more rewarding lives.

Through a combination of 12 step programs, individual and group therapy, peer mentoring, and house activities, our transition house will help identify healthy coping mechanisms to support sobriety and live successfully without the use of substances.
